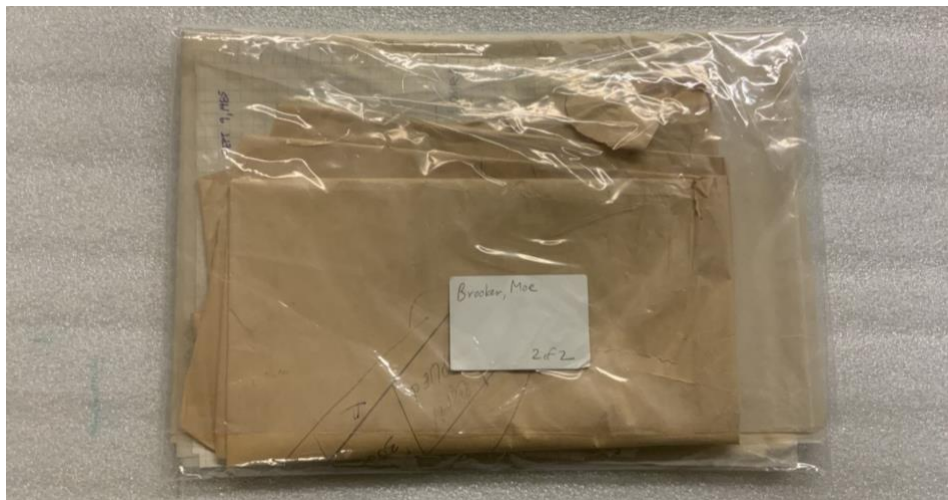


Bag entitled, "Brooker, Moe 1 of 2." Contains:

- 1 Prototype of the *Moché* quilt in black and grey.



- Prototype of *Moché* with grey cloth borders sewn together which is attached to the center black rectangular muslin interior. The interior has silver diagonal lines running across it with an occasional color block of yellow, pink, orange, or purple overlapping it: Approx. 102 x 90 inches.

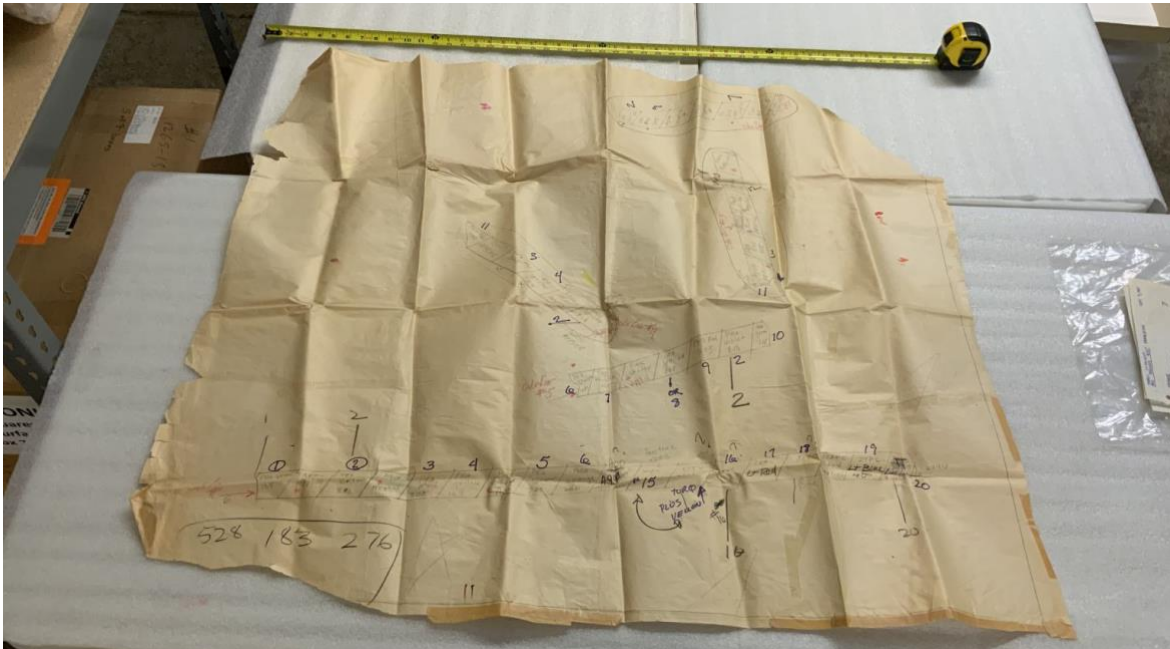


Bag entitled, "Brooker, Moe 2 of 2." Contains:

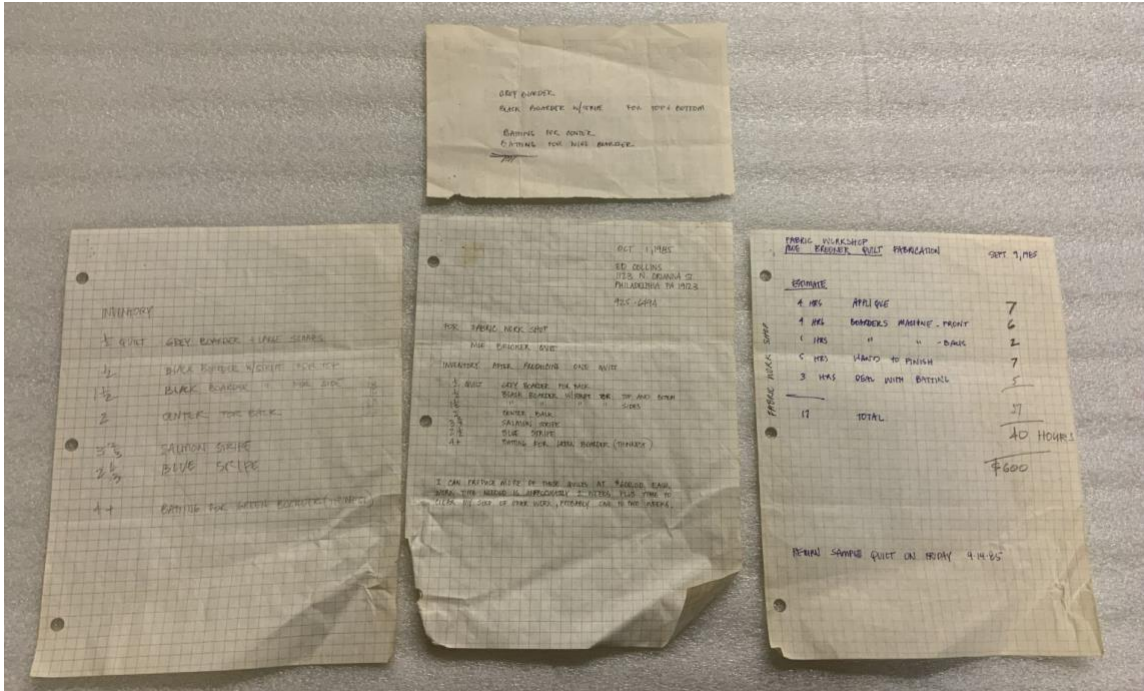
- 1 outline of *Moché* interior.
- 1 paper template with color formulas of *Moché*.
- 4 Sheets of paper with handwritten notes detailing quilt prices, hours, and inventory.
